

Exam 6 Study Sheets

These are Vessel Practice Sheets. They were made to HELP YOU STUDY YOUR VESSELS.

You'll see that there are unlabeled and labeled versions of the vessel sheets. The unlabeled ones are for you to PRACTICE ON. Remember, practice makes perfect! The labeled ones are for you to check your work. Just studying the labeled ones will do nothing for you.

How will learning these pathways help? Vessels branch and merge just like streets do. Learning the vessels of the body and which ones give rise to which by branching and merging is just like learning directions to a destination in your car.

If you correctly learn these vessel "maps" you can answer questions such as, "which of the following vessels gives rise to the left gastric artery?", and, "which of the following vessels merge to form the common iliac vein?".

So, when you get to the test and read a question like that, don't freak out and say to yourself, "I have no idea!", scribble your pathway on your test packet and find the answer!

BY THE WAY.....studying only this will not serve you well. Vessels are just one part of a very large exam. Doing well on vessels only will not be worth failing the rest of the exam. Make sure that you are studying respiratory, blood, heart and lymphatic chapters also!
